THE FFP-FAHP AND FFPC LEADERSHIP TRAINING AND REGIONAL
WORK CONFERENCES FOR SY 1987-88.

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The series of regional work-conferences of the Future Farmers of the Philippines (FFP), Future Agricultural Homemakers of the Philippines (FAHP) and Future Farmers of the Philippines Collegiate Chapter (FFPCC), scheduled for 1987-88, as embodied in DECS Memorandum No. 163, s. 1987 will focus on the theme "Economic Recovery Through the FFP-FAHP and FFPCC Activities." Inclosed is the tentative schedule of regional work conferences.
2. The attendance of the national and assistant national advisers to the regional work conferences is by invitation and as a matter of the FFP-FAHP National Board's policy. Their travel is chargeable against the host regional association.
3. The adult FFP-FAHP school officials should encourage active participation among the student officers and members in the planning, management and coordination of the various work conference activities in order to develop and improve students' leadership skills.
4. The usual chapter week celebration should be held prior to the holding of the regional conference. Academic and skills competition and literary musical contest should form part of the week's celebration, while regional conferences should focus on fewer competitive activities but more demonstrations on new technological skills and report of researches to help strengthen the knowledge of the members.
5. The giving of recognition and appropriate awards to deserving members should be done during the regional conferences.
6. The leadership training of the adult and student leaders is the responsibility of the regional organization.
7. To subsidize the training program, the regional associations are hereby authorized to charge reasonable training fees to cover board and lodging, handouts etc., charged against local school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
8. The yearly assessment of the chapter members should be conducted during the conference to re-cast/minimize irrelevant activities. The regional chairman should submit consolidated report of the regional work conference.
9. It is desired that this Memorandum be given the widest publicity possible for information and guidance of all concerned.
