UNITED WAY PHILIPPINES EDUCATION AND FUND CAMPAIGN

1. The United Way Philippines, Inc. (formerly Community Chests and Councils of the Philippines, Inc.), is an organization actively engaged in funding community health and welfare services as well as in promoting the economic well-being of people in the different parts of the country.
2. Proclamation No. 101 dated May 16, 1967, authorizes the United Way Philippines, Inc. to conduct an annual education and fund campaign during the period from April 1, 1967 to March 31, 1968. The Proclamation calls upon all residents, of whatever race or creed, business firms, organizations, and government officials and employees in the areas above-mentioned to fully support the campaigns of the United Way Philippines by giving generously of their means and volunteer efforts to this annual appeal campaign for the promotion of health, welfare and economic well-being of our less fortunate and underprivileged countrymen.
3. In view of the laudable objectives of this campaign, it is requested that school officials, teachers and other school personnel as well as pupils and students give their support to this campaign. However, the solicitation of contributions shall be voluntary, and based on human compassion and a willingness to share with those who are less fortunate in life.
4. In remitting collections, checks or money orders should be drawn in favor of the local United Way chapter. If there is no organized local chapter in the province/city, collections should be forwarded directly to United Way Philippines, Inc., 13 MacArthur Ext., Diliman, Quezon City. A list of active United Way local chapters is enclosed. Copies of the report on remittances should be transmitted to Dr. Diosdado P. Tuason, Assistant Secretary, Department of Education, Culture and Sports, Intramuros, Manila. Campaign fund receipts will be provided by the local chapter for remittances at chapter levels, and United Way Philippines, Inc. on the national level.
5. Dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is requested.
