FIRST NATIONAL CONFERENCE--KURKHOH TN SCHOOL  
FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT

1. The School Feeding and Food Service Management Association of the Philippines, Inc. (SchoFFSAMPI), with the cooperation of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports will hold its First National Conference--Kurkhoh TN School for Service Management on December 10-11, 1987 at the Queen City Division Multipurpose Hall, Queen Elizabeth St., Roxas District, Quezon City.

2. The theme of the conference is "The Future Food Service Manager: A Concerned and Committed Professional". It aims to:

- a. promote awareness on the role of School Feeding and Food Services in economic and social development;
  - b. inculcate and develop in the participants the values of a well-rounded, committed and competent professionals;
  - c. promote cultural exchange and fellowship among the participants; and
  - d. encourage participants to exhibit leadership as active members of the SchoFFSAMPI.
3. The participants to this conference are:
- a. DECS regional, division and district supervisors/coordinators and managers of school canteen and other food services;
  - b. dietary members managing the operating school canteens and food services and/or teaching food



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service/administration/financial management in schools, colleges and universities, both public and private; and

c. participation in private school canteens.

4. A tentative program of activities is enclosed. Resource speakers have been invited to share their expertise with emphasis on the concepts reflected in the objectives.

5. Registration fee of P100.00 will defray expenses for conference materials, snacks and lunches. Expenses to be incurred by the participants from DECS and state schools are chargeable against local funds, subject to its availability, and the usual accounting and auditing procedures. For the school and district participants in public schools, expenses will be charged against school canteen/district funds. The participants from the private schools may have their own arrangements with their respective schools. Owners of canteens/referaries may participate at their own personal expense.

6. It is requested that the participants bring with them any food delicacy or even handicrafts (indigenous or characteristic of their province or region) to be displayed/sold at the bazaar and fair.
