1. The National Academy of Science and Technology has launched the search for the Outstanding Young Scientists of the Philippines Award for 1988. Awards shall be given to young scientists who have made significant contribution(s) to science and technology development, specifically in the fields of Mathematical and Physical Sciences, Biological Sciences, Social Sciences, Agricultural Sciences and Health Sciences. Each awardee shall receive a trophy and a cash award of P10,000.00 from the Academy.

3. It is enjoined that this information be disseminated to all concerned as soon as possible, taking into consideration the December 31, 1987, deadline for submission of nomination(s).

NOMINATION AND SELECTION OF OUTSTANDING YOUNG SCIENTIST FOR 1988

Discipline

Outstanding Young Scientist of the Philippines Award for 1988 will be given in each of the following field:

- Mathematical and Physical Sciences
- Biological Sciences
- Social Sciences
- Agricultural Sciences
- Health Sciences

Awards

Each awardee shall receive a Presidential Trophy and a cash award of TEN THOUSAND PESOS (P10,000) from the National Academy of Science and Technology (NAST).

Qualifications

Nominee must meet the following minimum qualifications:

1. Filipino citizen of not more than 40 years old on 11 July 1988. (Not a day older than 40 years old).
2. At least a Bachelor's degree holder in one of the above major fields of science.
3. Major researcher of a project(s) or research activity(ies).

Selection criteria

Selection shall be based on the following criteria, among others:

1. Relevance of research project(s) or research activity(ies).
2. Quality of scientific works and publication(s).
3. Must be willing to read a scientific research paper within a year after presentation of the award.

Who will nominate

Nominations may be made by heads of government and private research institutions, colleges and universities, and professional organizations/associations and societies.

Where and when to submit nomination(s)

Nominations may be submitted to the National Academy of Science and Technology Secretariat, DOST Administration Bldg., Gen. Santos Ave., Bonuan, Taguig, Metro Manila on or before the end of December 1987.

Nomination must reach the Secretariat on or before December, 1987.
