
NATIONAL TRAINING OF REGIONAL AND DIVISION TRAINERS
IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION FOR GRADES V AND VI

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. The Bureau of Physical Education and School Sports (BPES) through its Curriculum Development Division (CDD) will conduct a 6-day National Training of Regional and Division Trainers in Physical Education for Grades V and VI at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on March 12-18.
2. The training aims to strengthen the team of Physical Education (P.E.) trainers in the regional and division levels through the enhancement of their competencies in the conduct and management of training programs for Grades V and VI P.E. teachers. The training focus will be the P.E. basic competency requirements for the teaching of P.E. in Grades V and VI.
3. Participants to this training will be two (2) Physical Education and School Sports (PESS) technical staff (any two of the supervising chief, assistant supervising chief, and general education supervisor II) per regional office and one (1) division trainer per schools division, preferably the division Physical Education/Physical Education and School Sports/Physical Education, Health and Music supervisor. Six (6) training/sports specialists in physical education will be invited to augment the training staff of the CDD.
4. After the national training, the regional PESS division supervisors together with the trained division trainers, are expected to conduct training programs for additional division trainers. These additional division PE trainers shall team up with the division PE trainers trained at the national level in conducting training programs in PE for the Grades V and VI teachers in their respective divisions.
5. Travel expenses of regional and division participants shall be charged against local funds while those of the DECS Central Office, BPES staff and invited training/sports specialists shall be charged against BPES funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Board and lodging of all participants, training/sports specialists and BPES management and support staff, and other expenses incidental to this activity shall be taken care of by the BPES.

6. Registration of participants will be on Tuesday, March 11 at the Quirino Hall, Teachers Camp. Food services will start with afternoon snack on the same day.

7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
