MONITORING OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF KNOW OUR HEROES
PROGRAM AND OTHER DECS PROGRAMS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports through its Technical Service has implemented the following projects during the school year 1995-1996 in the 16 regions through DECS Memorandums as follows: Know Our Heroes Program - DECS Memorandum No. 169, s. 1996; Establishing the KABAYANI Club - DECS Memorandum No. 325, s. 1996; and Mabuhay Campaign - DECS Memorandum No. 350, s. 1994.

2. In order to effectively assess the success of the abovementioned programs a National Monitoring Team (NMT) has been organized composed of personnel from the Technical Service and other officials from the Central Office (Inclosure No. 1).


3. The monitoring team shall visit selected schools/school divisions in the region from February 15 to March 30. It shall (a) assess extent of program implementation; (b) record and document the model school, identify division and Regional Program implementors; (c) project the effective and model implementors of the DECS programs; and (d) recognize the model implementors (Inclosure No. 2 - criteria).

4. Expenses including their transportation, board and lodging and other incidental expenses, in connection with the visit of the members of the monitoring team to the various regions and field offices, shall be chargeable against the "Know Our Heroes Program" subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. All regional directors, schools superintendents and heads of schools are enjoined to organize their monitoring team committees at their respective area of coverage to assess their implementation of the abovementioned programs; as well as assist the DECS Monitoring Team in their task during their visit.

6. The regional finalists of the various programs shall be selected at the regional levels while the national winners for each of the programs shall be announced by this office. The details of the national awards ceremonies shall be announced later.

7. The full cooperation and support of the regional directors in the proper dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to all concerned is enjoined.

----- 30 pts.
 3. The use of word "Mabuhay" in all
official communication (letters,
and publications)
----- 20 pts.
 4. Use of the word "Mabuhay" in
answering telephone calls instead
of hello and in greeting friends,
parents, teachers, visitors and
everyone.
----- 30 pts.
