

EXTRAMURAL PROGRAM FOR SOCIAL SCIENCE TEACHERS

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. The University of the Philippines, College of Social Sciences and Philosophy will conduct the Extramural Program for Social Science Teachers on May 2-10 at the University of the Philippines in Cebu City and on May 6-14 at the Palma Hall, U.P. Diliman, Quezon City.
2. The 9-day refresher course aims to revitalize the teaching of social science based on courses taught in both public and private schools. The topics and other pertinent information about the said course are inclosed.
3. The program accepts as many as 100 participants per venue. Those coming from the Visayas and Mindanao may attend the UP Cebu Training Program and those coming from Luzon, Bicol Region and NCR may attend the UP Diliman Training Program.
4. A registration fee of five thousand pesos (P5,000.00) shall be charged every participant to cover the cost of materials, honoraria for lecturers and meals (lunches and snacks). Transportation and other incidental expenses as well as the registration fee of participants from government schools may be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private institutions shall make their own financial arrangements with their respective schools.
5. Since this is a nine-day refresher course, the regional directors are requested to determine their training priority and the number of teachers to participate in the training program.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is expected.
