- 1. In line with the Adopt-A-School Program of the Department, the Philippine Journalist Inc. the publisher of the Philippine Journal, a daily broadsheet newspaper circulated nationwide has offered to allot one full page free of charge, every Friday for a period of one year starting on January 10, 1997 to January 9, 1998 from the Education Weekly page which shall feature the DECS issuances, policies, and innovative projects for the benefits of all public and private elementary and secondary administrators, teachers, students, pupils and parents nationwide.
