## SEVENTEENTH NATIONAL CONGRESS OF SECONDARY SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS

To:

Bureau Directors

Regional Directors

Schools Superintendents

Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

- 1. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports jointly with the Philippine Association of Secondary School Administrators (PASSA) will hold the Seventeenth National Congress of Secondary School Administrators at Teachers Camp, Baguio City, on April 28 to May 1, 1997. Registration begins at 1:00 O'clock of the 27th of April. The 4th day, May 1, will be especially devoted to the Vision and Challenges of the Filipino Youth. The theme of this year's Congress is Meeting the Global Challenges of Development Education. About 1,400 secondary school administrators are expected to attend.
- 2. The Congress will take up five signposts of the National Culture of Excellence: a) quality instruction; b) parental involvement; c) community orientation; d) over-all well-being; and e) arts and culture.
- 3. Participants in this conference are the following:
  - a. Chiefs or assistant chiefs of secondary education division;
  - b. Assistant schools superintendents in charge of secondary education;
  - c. Vocational school administrators, heads of craftsman/opportunity schools and home industries training supervisors;
  - d. Principals/head teachers/OIC/TIC of national general, comprehensive and vocational high schools (agriculture, fishery and arts and trades);
  - e. Heads/Directors of private secondary schools;
  - f. High school principals of state colleges and universities; and
  - g. Regional supervisors in charge of secondary education
  - h. Principals of DLS, RLS and ESEP Schools

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- A registration fee of three thousand five hundred pesos (P3,500.00) shall be charged each participant and committee members from DECS and government schools to cover board and lodging (from supper of 27 April to breakfast of 2 May) conference materials, speakers/facilitators/committees, handouts rentals, souvenir programs, conference kits and other incidental expenses chargeable against local/office funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private schools shall make arrangements with their respective institutions.
- Participants are discouraged from bringing their families with them as accommodations are limited. Those with heart ailment and/or hypertension are advised to come with medical certificates attesting their fitness to attend the Congress.
- Members of the different committees shall be considered participants and shall pay the registration fee of F3,500.00 and are authorized to travel two days before the Congress.

Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is expected. 7.
