1. The Philippine Teachers' Foundation, Inc. (PTFInc.) announces the holding of its 2nd Annual National Convention on May 2-4 at the JE Camp in Tanay, Rizal with the theme "Quality Education Towards Philippines 2000".
2. This Annual National Convention aims to inform and update concerned institutions/sectors/individuals on the on-going projects of the Philippine Teachers' Foundation, Inc. in relation to the DECS' thrust on quality education.
3. Participants to the convention are classroom teachers from public and private schools and faculty members from the state colleges and universities.
4. A registration fee of three hundred pesos (₱300.00) to cover convention materials and certificates of participation will be charged each participant. Food and accommodation will be free since the Foundation has been able to solicit sponsors for these. Transportation and other allowable expenses of participants from government institutions/agencies may be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
5. Buses will be provided to take the participants to and from the convention site. Participants are advised to assemble beside the Uniwide Sales Warehouse Club and Jollibee at the EDSA Central, Mandaluyong City on the morning of May 2, between 6:30-7:30 a.m.
6. Latecomers are advised to commute to the convention site by taking either a jeepney plying the Tanay, Rizal route or an airconditioned RRCG bus located at the EDSA Central bus terminal. (It is right next to Mercury Drug Store).
7. Participants should prepare for a cultural night performance showcasing songs and/or dances emanating from their respective regions. They are likewise advised to bring additional beddings and swimming attire (if so desired).

8. Interested participants are requested to get in touch with the PTFInc. Office, Rm. D408B, Philippine International Convention Center, Roxas Boulevard, Pasay City, tel. nos. 831-69-09 and 832-03-09 local 7566 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. Deadline for receiving reservations shall be on April 25. Reservations shall be accepted on first come, first serve basis since the camp can accommodate 500 participants only.
