1. The IPG Professional Advancement and Business Center of the Philippines, a training institution accredited by the Civil Service Commission, is conducting a national seminar on "Philippine Folkdances: The Art of Movement as a Means of Communication" at the Grand Ballroom of the Century Park Hotel, Vito Cruz, Manila on May 19-21 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
