SIXTH SEAMEO INNOTECH INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

1. The Sixth Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization-Regional Center for Educational Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO-INNOTECH) International Conference will be held on November 11-13 at the Manila Hotel. The conference is jointly sponsored by SEAMEO INNOTECH, the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, the Commission on Higher Education and the Technical Skills Development Authority. Over 800 educators from about 45 countries and 16 international organizations are expected to attend.

2. The theme of the conference is "The Learning Society of the Future: Reconciling Education, Values and Technology for Social Transformation". The conference will provide a world-class forum for idea and experience exchange in preparation for the coming new millennium.



In view of the relevance of the theme to our programs, key education officials, heads, faculty members and researchers in both public and private educational institutions are hereby encouraged to attend. The special discounted registration fee for Filipino participants may be availed of. The rates are five thousand eight hundred fifty pesos (P5,850.00) for those who pay on or before September 30 and six thousand five hundred pesos (P6,500.00) for those who pay after this date.

4. Participants from DECS and state colleges and universities are authorized to charge their registration, transportation and related participation fees to their respective local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. It is reminded however, that the existing prohibition against public school teachers leaving their classes to attend seminars shall apply in this case. Participants from the private schools/universities shall make their own arrangements with their respective institutions.
