

19TH ANNIVERSARY AND 16TH ANNUAL CONVENTION OF PRIVATE  
SCHOOL HEALTH OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.

To: Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Private School Health Officers' Association, Inc. (PSHOA), will hold its 17th Anniversary and 16th Annual Convention with the theme "PSHOA's Global Concern on Health and Social Issues" on April 24-25 at the New Bayaninon Hall, United Laboratories, Inc., Mandaluyong City.

  - a. to enable participants/delegates to make a clear definition of the role of school health officers on the challenging problems concerning health and social issues;
