PLACEMENT OF DOST-SEI SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS GRADUATE
SCHOLARS INTO THE S & T ORIENTED HIGH SCHOOLS
OR IN ANY PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Science Education Institute (SEI) of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST), in cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS), announces the availability of DECS-SEI science and mathematics education scholars who are expected to graduate in March 1997.
2. As stipulated in the scholarship agreement, said scholars should teach in their respective home regions after graduation, preferably in the S & T oriented high schools or in any of the public high schools. In this connection, attention is hereby invited to Civil Service Commission Office Memorandum No. 50, s. 1994 (Appointment of DOST-SEI Teacher-Scholars on Provisional Status). See Inclosure No. 1.
3. An adequate number of new items shall be reserved to accommodate the new graduates in their regions as well as other scholars who are now employed in other institutions/agencies and who may want to join the public school system.
4. Salaries for the first three (3) months shall be borne by the Career Incentives Program (CIP) of the DOST-SEI provided these scholar-graduates shall be issued a provisional appointment for one (1) academic year in their home regions. Expenditures shall be subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. The list of DOST-SEI science and mathematics education scholars expected to graduate in March 1997 is shown in Inclosure No. 2.
6. Support for the improvement of science and mathematics education and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

Please be reminded that in the light of the objectives of CSC Resolution No. 91-157, the scholar-graduates of the Cooperative Pre-Service Education for Sciences and Mathematics Teacher Program of the DOST-Science Education Institute (SEI) may be appointed on provisional status until they pass the Professional Board Examination for Teachers (PBET) and register as professional teachers. The provisional appointment shall not, however, exceed four years in which case they shall be automatically replaced by qualified registered teachers who are immediately available for employment.
