1997 EDUCATORS CONGRESS

1. The 1997 Educators Congress will be held at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City on May 19-23. This year's theme is "The Quality of the Learner: A Closer Look" to bring to the fore the importance of taking the holistic view of the Filipino child, to enable each one to develop his/her full potential.
2. Authorized to attend are all undersecretaries and assistant secretaries, heads of SCU laboratory schools; heads of private elementary and secondary schools; directors, assistant directors, heads of units/services, and division chiefs at the central office, vocational school superintendents/administrators of training institutions, and congress committee members.
3. Each regional office shall be represented by the regional director, assistant regional director, chief of the elementary education division, secondary education division, nonformal education division, physical education and school sports division and the regional health and nutrition unit; one education supervisor, regional supervising dentist, and the nutritionist-dietitian II.
4. Each division shall likewise be represented by the schools superintendent, assistant schools superintendent/s; one principal from the elementary level; one principal from the secondary level; one parent from the PTCA; one medical officer; one education supervisor (Science and Health), and another education supervisor in-charge of Guidance.
5. Also invited to attend are representatives of GOs and NGOs involved in the advocacy and promotion of basic education programs and projects.


6. The conference fee is six thousand pesos (P6,000.00) to cover board, lodging, materials and kit. All delegates are encouraged to live-in at the venue. Live-out participants will pay five thousand five hundred pesos (P5,500.00) to cover board, materials and seminar kit.

7. All expenses, conference fees, board and lodging, and transportation of participants and committee members from DECS and government schools are chargeable against local/office funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private institutions shall charge their expenses from their respective institutions. The travel expenses of the parent representatives shall be charged from local funds; however, their registration fees shall be subsidized by the Congress.

8. No substitution of delegates shall be allowed; and the delegates identified in paragraphs nos. 3 and 4 are considered registered. Pre-registration with payment by region and by division is required. Inclosed is the form for this purpose, wherein the names of the delegates from the regional office or from the division office are to be printed. This list, together with the check paid to DECS, representing the full payment of conference fees of the delegates, should be submitted to the Office of Undersecretary Erlinda C. Pefianco on or before April 30.

9. The tentative program of activities, and a copy of the registration form are inclosed for the guidance of all concerned.

10. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
