SEMINAR FOR SCHOOL LIBRARIANS

To: Bureau Directors

- 1. The Philippine Association of School Librarians, Inc. (PASL) in cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) will conduct a four-day seminar-workshop on "The School Librarians in Pursuit of Educational Excellence" on May 7-10, at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
- 2. The objectives of the seminar are: (a) to foster a positive environment that encourages inquiry and discovery through the use of information technology; (b) to develop the capabilities of the school librarians in organizing and managing the library records; and (c) to identify effective techniques in marketing the resources of school libraries.
- 3. Participants will be charged a registration fee of two thousand five hundred pesos (\$2,500.00) for live in participants and two thousand pesos (\$2,000.00) for live out. This will include board and lodging, certificates, handouts, kits, etc. chargeable against local funds and such other funds available in the school, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from the private institutions shall make their own financial arrangements with their respective schools/institutions.
