1. The 28th National Conference of Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary Education will be held at the Boracay Sea Wind Resort, Malay, Aklan on May 5-9. The theme of the conference is "Meeting Educational Challenges of the Next Millennium".
2. The conference aims to:
 - a. utilize educational researches and best practices, to meet the challenges of the next millennium;
 - b. adapt new roles and tasks of the BEE and EED to realities and future orientations;
 - c. formulate regional initiatives or intervention programs internally and externally responsive to the needs of the new culture for a new school; and
 - d. generate strategies that foster effective schools based on available resources and future shared visions.
3. Participants to this conference are the bureau director, assistant director, chiefs and assistant chiefs of the Bureau of Elementary Education, and the chiefs and assistant chiefs of the Elementary Education Division of the sixteen (16) regions (list inclosed).
4. Travel expenses and a registration fee of five thousand five hundred pesos (₱5,500.00) per participant to cover board and lodging and other related expenses in lieu of per diem shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
