FIRST ASIAN YOUTH FOOTBALL INTERNATIONAL JAMBOREE

- 1. The province of Laguna and the Philippine Football Federation (PFF) is hosting the "First\_Asian\_Youth, Football International Jamboree" dubbed as "Laquna Cup" on December 26-31 at the foot of the Mt. Makiling, Laguna where some 5,000 to 10,000 youths, 14 years old and under are expected participate.
- The tournament, organized by the Provincial Government of Laguna is similar to Gothia Cup, Helsinki Cup, Dallas Cup, San Francisco Cup, etc. with specific objective of providing a venue for Asian countries to meet each other in an atmosphere of genuine friendship and establish friendly contacts among young people and parents alike.
- The tournament is designed to provide experiences will develop skills in football as well as socially accepted values such as camaraderie, sportsmanship, fairplay, etc.
- The DECS is encouraging school football participate and avail of the opportunity to play with the youth of Asian countries. The age groups are as follows: 10 years under; 12 years under, 14 years under and 16 years under.

There will be a flower and garden show, trade and food fair, scientific symposium, welcome party (Filipino fiesta), nightly presentation of teams, etc.
