MONITORING RESOURCE MANAGEMENT COURSE RE-ENTRY PROJECTS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
All Officials Concerned

1. In a series of seminars nationwide for SY 1996, the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) in cooperation with the U.P. Public Administration Foundation conducted a Resource Management Course (RMC) to four batches of administrators (I, II, III, IV) with the following objectives:

- a. to develop new values and knowledge on resource management as a critical function of all DECS education administrators;
- b. to enable DECS education administrators to acquire and apply in their ordinary work situation a system orientation and the value of productivity and quality; and
- c. to enhance the understanding of education administrators of the basic processes and techniques in resource generation and management, strengthening of community participation at the school level in resource management and project management.

2. Participants were required to undertake Re-Entry Projects (see inclosed list), the completion of which entitles each participant to a Certificate of Completion of the course.

3. Considering the enormous potential benefits these projects could contribute to the improvement of the system in general and the regions in particular, there is a need to see that these are implemented and monitored by the regions after which NEAP will undertake final evaluation.
