1997 REPUBLIC OF KOREA AND PHILIPPINE ESSAY COMPETITION

- 1. In order to involve the tremendous capability and creativity of the Filipino youth in strengthening the cultural understanding, international goodwill and promote brotherhood among our peoples, the Embassy of the Republic of Korea in the Philippines and the Department of Education, Culture and Sports are jointly sponsoring the 1997 Republic of Korea and the Philippines Essay Competition.
- 2. The theme of the contest is "Strengthening RP-ROK Relations toward the 21st Century".
- 3. The competition aims to develop a deeper appreciation and understanding of the culture of the people in the Republic of Korea among our school youth, and instill a sense of responsibility and concern to our foreign neighbors.
- 4. The contest is open to students currently enrolled in both public and private secondary and tertiary institutions.
- 5. The deadline for submission of entries to the National Secretariat is August 20. Selection of winners shall be conducted on mid-September 1997 and announcement. Will follow immediately. Awarding ceremony will be held on October 2.

HOW TO JOIN

College level

- 1. 1,500 words.
- The essay must be submitted in short bond paper, typewritten or hand written double spaced. Length of essay should be between 500 to 700 words.
- The essay must contain the name and signature of the 3. It should be accompanied by a duly accomplished entry form which may be secured from their respective school teachers and principals. If it is more

convenient, students may type out their own entry forms using the format prescribed in the announcement or make xerox copies of entry forms available at the schools.

- 4. Family members, friends and advisers may not in any manner write a part or the whole of the essay. They may only provide advice and encouragement. Any proven fraudulent work will be automatically disqualified and will bar the student from participating in the future contest that the organizers will undertake.
- 5. Mailed entries should be postmarked not later than August 20, 1997 and actually received at the 1997 ROK-RP Essay Competition National Secretariat not latter than August 31, 1996.
- 6. All entries shall become the Property of ROK-RP Essay Competition National Secretariat.

JUDGING:

- 1. Judging shall be done by a Board of Judges composed of leaders in government, the academe, mass media and business.
- 2: Proof of authenticity of work may be required during the judging.
- 3. The Board of Judges shall select the three best entries from among all those submitted nationwide and declare them as first, second, and third place in the national category, after which the three best entries of each region shall be declared winners on the regional level.
- 4. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and unappealable.
- 5. First Prize winner for high school and first prize winner for college will be invited to Korea from Oct/ber 5 to 12, 1997

AWARDING:

- 1. Winners will be notified by mail. Awarding for the national winners shall be done as a venue in Metro Manila on October 2, 1997.
