

CORRIGENDUM TO DECS MEMORANDUM NO. 102, S. 1997
(Placement of DOST-SEI Science and Mathematics Graduate
Scholars Into the S & T Oriented High Schools or in Any
Public High School)

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational Schools Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Science Education Institute (SEI) of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST), in cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS), announced the availability of DOST-SEI science and mathematics education scholars who graduated last March.
2. Item 4 of the abovementioned DECS Memorandum states: "Salaries for the first three (3) months shall be borne by the Career Incentives Program (CIP) of the DOST-SEI provided these scholar-graduates shall be issued a provisional appointment for one (1) academic year in their home regions. Expenditures shall be subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations."
3. However, due to budgetary constraints, the Career Incentives Program (CIP) is no longer implemented by SEI-DOST. Hence, Item 4 is deleted.
4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
