
### GUIDELINES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMPUTER TRAINING PROGRAM

To : All Regional Directors

- 1. In connection with the DECS computer training program, a number of training providers have now been accredited for this summer's training program only. (Please see Attachment A.) Evaluation and accreditation of providers for subsequent training programs will continue.
- 2. For the training of teachers, administrators and support staff scheduled this summer, the Central Office shall assign and contract one or more NEAP-accredited training provider(s) for the regions. (Please see Attachment B.) Management of training and payment of training providers will be by the regional offices.
- 3. The following are the guidelines for the implementation of the computer training program:
  - a. The training shall begin anytime this summer, provided the training for teachers finishes on or before the opening of schools on June 2, 1997.
  - b. The signing of contracts between the DECS, Regional Directors and training providers will be on Friday, May 09, 1997 at the OSEC Conference Room at 12:00 noon.
  - Funds for this purpose have been transferred to the regions from the Central Office. Payments shall be made by the regional offices;
  - d. Board and lodging of trainees shall be borne by the regions; transportation to and from the training venue and per diems will be charged against local funds.

- e. Regions may increase but NOT decrease the number of trainees, provided the expenses and other related concerns shall be agreed upon by the contracting parties, and provided further that these can be accommodated during the specified time for training.
- f. The National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), the Center for Education Technology (CEI), and the Task Force on DECS Computerization will monitor the implementation of the training in every region to ensure compliance with the DECS standards and criteria. The regions are therefore requested to submit their schedules for training as soon as possible to:
