MAKING PHYSICS MORE RELEVANT TO SOCIETY IN THE 21ST CENTURY

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Philippine Association of Physics Instructors (PAPI) in coordination with Central Luzon State University (CLSU) will sponsor the 1997 PAPI Convention and Workshop on May 27-29 at CLSU Campus, Munoz, Nueva Ecija.
2. The theme of this year's convention and workshop is "Making Physics More Relevant to Society in the 21st Century" of which the main goal is to improve physics education through the workshops that will be conducted by the following Physics teams from:
 - a. UP-Institute of Science and Mathematics Development, Quezon City;
 - b. Don Bosco College, Mandaluyong City;
 - c. Technological University of the Philippines, Manila; and
 - d. Edu-Vision 2000, a corporation that specializes in CAI (Computer Assisted Instruction) for Science and Mathematics.
3. The convention will also award cash and trophies to the winners of the three categories in the contest for (a) improvised Physics apparatus, (b) audio-visual aids, and (c) written teaching materials (modules, programmed instruction).
4. Participants to the convention cum workshops are physics teachers from public and private secondary schools.
5. A registration fee of one thousand two hundred pesos (P1,200.00) per participant will be charged to cover expenses for board and lodging (three days), annual dues, and convention materials.
6. Transportation and other expenses incident to attendance in the convention may be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private schools shall make their financial arrangements with their respective institutions.

7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
