

FOUNDATION COURSE ON ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

1. The Resource Center for Environment and Sustainable Development (RCESD) of the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP) will conduct its regular Foundation Course on Environmental Management (FCEM) at Antipolo, Rizal on May 19-24, 1997.
2. The six-day live-in course is in keeping with the government's thrust of making sustainable development a national crusade and giving environmental concerns priority attention in the country's development program. Specifically, the course is designed to develop the capability of the participants to undertake development initiatives in line with the principles of environmental management (EM), the Philippine Strategy for Sustainable Development (PSSD) and the Philippine Agenda 21.
3. Participants to this course are regional directors, assistant regional directors, senior planning officers/policy-making officers and development officers.
4. A fee of Ten Thousand Pesos (P10,000.00) will be charged each participant to include transportation, board and lodging for five days, field trips and course materials.
