> AMENDMENT TO DECS MEMORANDUM NO. 119, S. 1997 (SEARCH FOR THE MOST OUTSTANDING IMPLEMENTORS OF THE NATIONAL DRUG EDUCATION PROGRAM (NDEP))

To: **Bureau Directors** Regional Directors Schools Superintendents Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

Paragraph 1 of DECS Memorandum No. 119, s. 1997 is hereby amended to read: 1.

The Department of Education, Culture and Sports, in collaboration with the Dangerous Drugs Board announces the nationwide Search for the Most Outstanding Implementors of the NDEP in all public and private elementary and secondary schools.

- During the monitoring and national evaluation, tertiary schools shall be excluded; instead, 2. one additional randomly selected secondary school shall be visited during the monitoring phase; and during the national evaluation, one elementary school, two secondary schools and two randomly selected schools (one elementary and one secondary) will be evaluated.
- Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired. 3.
