RESTRUCTURING THE INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS COUNCIL (IMC) SECRETARIAT

As part of measures to strengthen the Instructional Materials Council (IMC), including its Secretariat, in order to adequately and effectively respond to the needs of the textbook privatization program mandated by RA 8047 (Book Publishing Industry Development Act), as well as the need to modernize and ensure the quality of textbooks and other instructional materials used by the Department, the following organizational restructuring measures are hereby directed:

The present IMC Secretariat members are reassigned as follows:
