1997 NATIONAL DISABILITY PREVENTION AND REHABILITATION (NDPR) WEEK

- 1. The 1997 or the 19th National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation (NDPR) Week will be observed on July 13-19 with the theme: Kahit May "K" Okey! Kapansanan: Di Hadlang sa Kaunlaran.
- The objectives of the observance of the NDPR Week are:
 - a. To generate public awareness and strengthen the involvement of the different government and non-government organizations, including persons with disabilities themselves, on efforts to promote disability prevention, rehabilitation, and equalization of opportunities;
 - b. To serve as a vehicle of information for programs being implemented to promote the welfare of persons with disabilities;
 - To generate media support and participation in disability concerns; and
 - d. To highlight the observance of the Asian and Pacific Decade of Disabled Persons (1993-2002).
- 3. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) being a member agency of the governing board of the National Council for the Welfare of Disabled Persons (NCWDP) shall take part in the implementation of activities lined up for the occasion. Suggested activities for the line agencies are found in the inclosure.
- 4. Schools are enjoined to undertake activities relevant to the theme of the celebration. The Regional Special Education Council (RSEC) is the designated body which shall coordinate the implementation of the activities in cooperation with other GOs and NGOs in the regions.
