PILOT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE YOUTH ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND COOPERATIVE IN SCHOOLS PROGRAM

- 1. **Background.** The Department of Education, Culture and Sports signed a Memorandum of Agreement with the Office of Youth Sector Representative Anna Marie Periquet, Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) and the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PCCI) to establish and implement the Youth Entrepreneurship and Cooperative in Schools Program dubbed as the YECS sa DECS Program.
- 2. **Objectives.** The YECS Program aims to establish entrepreneurship and cooperative organizations in both public and private secondary schools nationwide with the goal to develop and cultivate a culture of entrepreneurship and cooperativism among the students, promote the value of cooperation and spirit of teamwork through the formation of small enterprises, help alleviate poverty and encourage long-range development growth in the countryside through career enhancement programs and provision of alternative measures for income generation.
- 3. Target Beneficiaries. The main beneficiaries for the YECS are all high school students from both public and private institutions nationwide.

- 4. **Scope.** The first year of implementation, that is School Year 1997-98, will consist of a pilot project to be carried out among 23 selected public schools and areas representing all the DECS regions in the country. Thereafter, upon proper evaluation of the pilot implementation, YECS shall be established and implemented in all public and private high schools nationwide.
- 5. Activities. To launch the YECS Program, a National Orientation Forum and Moderators' Training will be held on June 17-20 and June 20 25 at the Subic International Hotel, Olongapo City and at the Pollock Center of the Ateneo de Manila University, Quezon City, respectively.

To implement its pilot project in the school level, various activities are lined up such as a comprehensive theoretical training on the basics and foundations of entrepreneurship and cooperatives, an extensive training on the values necessary for entrepreneurs and cooperators, participation in fora and symposia, field trips and other activities.

6. **Participants.** For the National Orientation Forum, twenty three (23) co-moderators, who may either be Regional THE Supervisors or Divisional THE Supervisors as identified by the Regional Directors, shall only participate in the National Orientation Forum.

For the Moderators' Training, twenty three (23) moderators from the preidentified 23 pilot schools, who are THE teachers, shall be required to participate both in the National Orientation Forum and the Moderators' Training.

7. Funding Source. Funds for the National Orientation Forum and the Moderators' Training shall be sourced from the DECS Central Office. However, funds for the transportation expenses may be charged from the local funds.

Budget for the school level pilot implementation of the YECS Program shall also be sourced from the local funds.
