2. The exhibits include the following:

1. **SIGARILYO: The Cigarette Wrapper as Art**
Galeriya Anita Magsaysay Ho
May 6 - June 15, 1997

The exhibition features 19th early 20th century wrappers from the collection of historian Ambeth R. Ocampo. Although created for a specific function, they are also a documentation of the time and fine samples of graphic art.

2. **Portrait Photography from Germany 1850-1918**
Upper Level Walk
May 22 - June 15, 1997

The exhibition features different portraits. Photography studios kept up with the latest innovations, attracting more customers and insuring portrait photography's popularity.


3. SALAKAI
Tall Galleries
June 3 - July 5, 1997

This exhibition stresses the importance of group work. It features sculptural works created by students of SALAKAI (Sanayan Lapat-Kamay, Inc.), a guild founded by Filipino artist Jerusalino Araos.

4. Emily Cheng Small Works
Upper Level
June 26 - July 24, 1997

The exhibition features works on paper by US-based Filipino artist Emily Cheng.
