## INCLUSION OF ENERGY CONSERVATION CONCEPTS/LESSONS IN LAC SESSIONS

- 1. In order to institutionalize and further reinforce the Power Conservation Program of the National Committee on Power Conservation and Demand Management, it is suggested that concepts/lessons on energy conservation be discussed in the Learning Action Cell (LAC) sessions of Grades V and VI teachers. Also known as Power Patrol Program, this is spearheaded by the Department of Energy in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports.
- 2. Supervisors and administrators are hereby requested to closely supervise and monitor the inclusion of the aforementioned energy conservation concepts/topics in the conduct of LAC sessions of Grades V and VI teachers, particularly in Science, Mathematics and Sibika to ensure the effectiveness and continuity of the Program.
- It is also suggested that contests be conducted in different categories such as
  poster making, oratorical, rap, jingle, highest percentage savings and other similar contests
  as culminating activity of the said Program.
- Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
