

INCLUSION OF ENERGY CONSERVATION CONCEPTS/LESSONS
IN LAC SESSIONS

Directors of Services/Centers and Heads of Units/Centers
Schools Superintendents

1. In order to institutionalize and further reinforce the Power Conservation Program of the National Committee on Power Conservation and Demand Management, it is suggested that concepts/lessons on energy conservation be discussed in the Learning Action Cell (LAC) sessions of Grades V and VI teachers. Also known as Power Patrol Program, this is spearheaded by the Department of Energy in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports.
2. Supervisors and administrators are hereby requested to closely supervise and monitor the inclusion of the aforementioned energy conservation concepts/topics in the conduct of LAC sessions of Grades V and VI teachers, particularly in Science, Mathematics and Sibika to ensure the effectiveness and continuity of the Program.
3. It is also suggested that contests be conducted in different categories such as poster making, oratorical, rap, jingle, highest percentage savings and other similar contests as culminating activity of the said Program.
4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
