EGYPT IN THE EYES OF CHILDREN OF THE WORLD PAINTING COMPETITION

1. The National Center for Children's Culture in cooperation with the Foreign Cultural Relations, Egyptian Ministry of Culture (The Superior Council of Culture) will organize the 6th "Egypt in the Eyes of Children of the World Painting Competition". The contest is open to all schoolchildren in public and private schools between the ages 4 and 15.
2. The aim of the competition is to allow children to express their knowledge and point of view of Egypt through their paintings.
3. Participants may draw in free hand using any type of paint or marker except pencil on a 30 x 40 cm paper. Entries must be submitted on or before July 1, 1997 to:

Prizes include free air tickets to the first, second and third prize winners with 50% discount for one accompanying person per child; gold and silver medals; and certificates.

Rules for the 1997 Competition

1. The competition is open to children all over the world, between the ages 4 and 15.
2. The purpose in participating is to allow children from all over the world to express their knowledge and point of view of Egypt through their paintings.
3. Every entry should carry the following information typed in English and/or Arabic in block letters, on the back of the painting:
 - Full name
 - Sex
 - Date of birth
 - Nationality
 - Full address
 - Title of the entry
4. The size of each entry should be 30x40 cm.
5. Black pencil drawings will not be accepted.
6. No entry will be returned.
7. The last date for receipt of entries is July 1st, 1997.
8. Prizes: Gold and silver medals and certificates.

Egypt Air Co. will award three free tickets on their Air Line to the top winners from different countries, including a discount of 50% on tickets for one accompanying person per child.

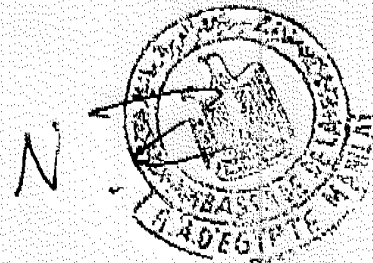
Kindly find herewith booklet containing all the information concerning the rules of the above-mentioned competition in English and the prizes which will be received by the winners.
