1997 REGIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. A Regional Training Program for School Paper Advisers will be held between June and August 1997 at different venues in each of the regions intended to replicate the training undergone by the school paper advisers during the National Conference-Workshop for School Paper Advisers held at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on May 7-10.
2. Specifically, the regional training program aims to:
 - a. upgrade the teaching competencies and journalistic skills of the school paper adviser;
 - b. equip the school paper adviser with relevant skills to meet the technological needs in broadcast journalism of the next millennium; and
 - c. strengthen his commitment towards the pursuit of excellence in campus journalism.
3. Participants in this training program are the school paper advisers from both elementary and secondary schools of the region as reflected in the training design submitted to and approved by the Bureau of Secondary Education.
4. The regional training program shall be subsidized from the 1996 Campus Journalism Fund based on the number of divisions by region and the subsidy shall be released upon approval of the training design submitted in Baguio.
5. BSE/BEE staff and officers/members of the NSPAA/NESPAA shall monitor the regional training in accordance with the schedule stated in the approved training design.
6. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
