CULTURAL CONTESTS

1. Search for Miss FFPCC

Category:

- best in sports wear
- best in casual wear
- best in Regional attire

2. Vocal Solo (pop song in Filipino) with recorded accompaniment

3. Vocal Duet (pop song in Filipino) with recorded accompaniment

4. Extemporaneous Speaking

Guidelines:

- a. 3 minutes preparation
- b. 5 minutes delivery

5. Battle of the Brains

Guidelines:

- a. Contestants will be given 10 seconds to answer the questions.
- b. Winners will be determined by the number of correct answers.
- c. There should be 1 FFP; 1 FAHP and 2 FFPCC contestants per region.

6. Declamation in English

Guidelines:

- a. The piece must be suited for a declamation.
- b. The delivery must not exceed 7 minutes.
- c. The delivery must give more emphasis on facial expression and no other parts of the body touches the ground except the feet.
- d. The use of vulgar words in the contest piece is discourage.

7. For manipulative skills contest in FFP Agriculture and Fisheries, the contestants shall bring the necessary tools and equipment.

8. The FFP trade contest such as building wiring contestants must provide their own materials and tools.

9. For FAHP manipulative skills contests in cooking, the host school will only provide the stove and the contestants will provide the ingredients. For sewing contest, the host will take charge of the sewing machine.

Note: *For those who will not bring the materials and ingredients, contestants should coordinate earlier with the management.*
