- 1. In compliance with Republic Act No. 6759, "An Act Declaring August 1 of Each Year as White Cane Safety Day in the Philippines and for Other Purposes", the theme for this year's celebration is "Accessibility for the Blind and Children with Low Vision".
- 2. All public and private schools with special education programs are encouraged to observe this day with appropriate activities which include the following:
 - a. Awareness campaign concerning the education of visually impaired children by inviting blind students or educators as resource persons and other professionals working for the blind;
 - b. School forum to be attended by blind educators or students, SPED or regular teachers, principals, supervisors and parents for the discussion of topics like:
 - 1) Early Intervention for Blind Children;
 - 2) Inclusive School for the Blind;
 - Vocational Rehabilitation for Independent Living; and
 - Computer Education for the Visually Impaired.

- Sportsfest and recreational activities to be participated in by blind children and those with low vision; and
- d. Display of projects made by blind students.
- 3. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
