SECOND NATIONAL TRAINING ON THE EDUCATION
OF CHILDREN WITH LOW VISION

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Private Elementary School Principals

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education in coordination with the Resources for the Blind, Inc. will sponsor the Second National Training on the Education of Children with Low Vision. This will be held at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City on September 22-26. The training will be conducted by Dr. Jill Keefee of the Low Vision Project International, University of Melbourne, Australia.
2. The training aims to improve the participants' competence on planning individualized education program for children with low vision and providing appropriate intervention through environmental modifications and the use of low vision devices and the most suitable format or medium of learning.
3. The participants to this training are the twenty (20) country and regional trainers who attended the first national training. The names of these trainers are found in the inclosure.
4. The travel, board and lodging expenses of the participants will be borne by the Resources for the Blind, Inc.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
