## POSTER CONTEST RE THE 30TH ANNIVERSARY OF ASEAN

- 4. Dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly requested.



## POSTER COMPETITION FOR HIGH SCHOOL CHILDREN TO COMMEMORATE THE 30TH ANNIVERSARY OF ASEAN

## INTRODUCTION

The 30th Anniversary of the Association of South East Asian Nations falls on 8 August 1997. To commemorate this historic occasion, the ASEAN Secretariat, together with the ASEAN National Secretariats of the ten ASEAN Member Countries, is launching a poster competition for high school children aging from 13 to 17 years old. The theme of the poster competition is "A united and cohesive ASEAN".

#### COMPETITION RULES

#### General Rules

The competition is open to all high school children aging from 13 to 17 years old who are nationals of the ten ASEAN Member Countries.

#### Technical Rules

- Each design should be in full colour.
- Each entry must be accompanied with a description of the poster design.
- Each design must measure at least 30 cm by 40 cm in size.
- The name, address, telephone number and age of each competitor should be clearly written on the back right-hand corner of the entry.
- Each competitor may send in more than one entry.

#### Submission

- All entries must reach the ASEAN Secretariat by 30 September 1997.
- All entries must be submitted in a sealed package marked "ASEAN Poster Competition" and sent to the:

ASEAN Secretariat 70A, Jalan Sisingamangaraja Jakarta 12110 Indonesia

- The organisers of the competition will not be responsible for any photographs lost in transit.
- All entries are non-returnable and non-acknowledgeable upon receipt.
- The organisers retain the right to reproduce all entries for any promotional campaigns, exhibitions, publications, and any other applications such as posters, calendars, and cards.

### Selection

- Twelve winning entries will be selected by a panel of judges from the ASEAN Member Countries.
- The decision of the panel of judges is final and no correspondence is entertained.

- The winning entries will be announced in a press release to be disseminated to all the major ASEAN newspapers, television networks and radio stations.
- The first, second and third prize winners will attend an Award Presentation Ceremony at the Commemorative Summit/ASEAN Secretariat in December 1997.
