ANNOUNCING THE SAC-CD INTER-REGIONAL, REGIONAL AND PROVINCIAL ECHO SEMINARS

- 1. The Students Assistance Committee for Community Development (SAC-CD) is a DECS-supervised agency that encourages college students and instructors to develop the value of concern for their community and to actively engage in community development activities throughout the year and especially during the summer recess. Every year, from September to December, it sponsors inter-regional, regional and provincial seminars.
- 2. Students and school officials in public and private institutions, especially those in depressed provinces, are urged to attend these seminars. The delegates are expected and encouraged to organize a Youth Community Service Club in their school. All YCSC members are insured by the CIGNA Insurance Company.
- The SAC-CD shoulders all expenses for board and lodging and seminar kits. Transportation expenses may be charged against school funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. SAC-CD extends financial assistance to provincial echo seminars and to councils that will work in a six-week summer practicum in a depressed community. It also gives scholarships to deserving YCSC members.
- 4. Posters, flyers and leaflets will be provided upon request. For other details, interested parties may inquire from or visit the SAC-CD Office, Room 101, Dorm. B, Philippine Sports Commission Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.
