

- In celebration of the National Heroes Day on August 31, 1997, the KABAYANI Club under the Know Your Heroes Program, in close cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS), launches one of its major projects entitled "Araw ng KABAYANI".
- The objectives of this celebration are to:
 - a. provide the Filipino youth a venue for rediscovering their historical and cultural identity;
 - b. identify and honor dead or living heroes in each locality:
 - c. enliven the values Maka-Diyos, Maka-Bayan, Maka-Tao and Maka-Kalikasan among the youth through personal and in-depth association with the life of their local heroes; and
 - d. encourage a more active and significant participation of the youth in the celebration of National Heroes Day.
- 3. School KABAYANI club advisers, officers and members are free to plan and implement their programs within the week before August 31, the actual National Heroes Day. Inclosed is the guidelines for this event.

- 4. Regional directors and schools superintendents are enjoined to include a report of this celebration in this year's annual report.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is enjoined.

Implementing Guidelines

ARAW NG KABAYANI

- 1. Conformably with Republic Act No. 3827, declaring last Sunday of August of every year as National Heroes Day, the KABAYATI Club will celebrate its ARAW NG KABAYANI. The celebration will give tribute to national heroes with emphasis on honoring the dead and living heroes in their locality.
- 2. The objectives of this celebration are to:
 - a) provide the Filipino youth a venue for rediscovering their historical and cultural identity;
 - b) identify and honor dead or living heroes in each locality;
 - c) to enliven the values MakaDlyos, MakaBayan, MakaTao and MakaKalikasan among the youth through personal and in-depth association with the life of their local heroes; and
 - d) encourage a more active and significant participation of the youth in the celebration of National Heroes Day.
- 3. The Araw ng KABAYANI may be celebrated any day in the week before the actual National Heroes Day. However, if the KABAYANI Club adviser feels the need to celebrate it more than the suggested number of days, she/he is free to do so.
- 4. The KABAYANI Club members will identify dead and living heroes in their localities. To further acquaint the members with the heroes, they may do a thorough study of the lives of the heroes. The researches done by the members, may be presented to the public in any form during the day of celebration.
- 5. The KABAYANI Club adviser together with the officers of the club may prepare the program for the celebration. The activities may be in the form of short productions, contests, show, etc.
- 4. To culminate the celebration, the members of the KABAYANI Club will choose one of the known heroic traits of their chosen hero and make a pledge to emulate that trait. The pledge will in the form below:
