1997 MUSIC EDUCATION SEMINAR-WORKSHOP

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Philippine Society for Music Education, in cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports and the University of Sto. Tomas will conduct a seminar on Music Education on October 24-26 at the Albertus Magnus Auditorium, UST, España, Manila.
2. The theme of the seminar is "Computer/Information Technology in Music Education".
3. The objectives of the seminar include the following:
 - a. Generate awareness and appreciation of the role of technology in music education;
 - b. Provide music teachers with basic information regarding the use of computer music software as new tools in music teaching and learning; and
 - c. Provide direction for the design or enhancement of strong music programs relevant to scientific and technological change.
4. Expected participants are music supervisors and coordinators, music deans of colleges and universities, elementary and secondary music teachers, and other interested teachers.

5. To avoid disruption of classes, no public school teachers will be allowed to attend the seminar during class days.

6. A seminar fee of two thousand five hundred pesos (P2,500.00) will be charged each participant to cover the cost of handouts, honoraria for lecturers, technological equipment and for miscellaneous expenses. Expenses of participants from the public educational institutions shall be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private institutions shall make funding arrangements with their respective schools/offices.

7. Due to limited accommodations, those interested may make their reservations through the UST Conservatory of Music, c/o Dr. Pilar Jimenez, tel. no. 731-40-22 and/or c/o P. Gomez Elementary School through Bing Deveza, tel. no. 735-07-97 on or before October 7.
