18th ANNUAL CMLI GRADE SCHOOL CONFERENCE



1. The Children's Museum and Library Inc., (CMLI) will hold its 18th Annual Grade School Conference at the Teachers' Camp, Baguio City from September 4 to 7, 1997.
2. The convention will focus on the theme, "The Family as Catalyst in Bringing About Consciousness Towards Sustainable Ecological Balance." Activities will include commission discussion and group dynamic sessions featuring modules on leadership training and values formation, interpersonal relations and communications, competitions on story-writing, story-telling, poem writing and delivery and poster-making contest. There will also be cultural performances to showcase individual and collective talents.
3. Each participant must be a bona-fide and an outstanding elementary pupil who must satisfy at least one of the following requirements: a member of the honor roll, an officer for the student council, an editor of the school paper and an officer of any school-based organization.
4. A convention fee of THREE THOUSAND PESOS (P3,000.00) will be charged each delegate to cover board and lodging and conference materials. Expenses to cover both travel and conference fee of participants from public schools may be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations or may be shouldered by sponsoring agencies/organizations. Participants from private institutions should make arrangements with their respective institutions.

5. Student delegates will undergo make-up classes to cover lessons missed from September 4 to 7, 1997. Teachers may be allowed to participate provided appropriate substitutes are available for the same period.

GUIDELINES

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** The conference is open to students of public and private elementary schools nationwide. Schools are advised to send their top students consisting of student council, school paper editors, members of the honor roll and officers of their school organizations. Aside from leadership and academic qualifications, each delegate must be of good moral character and good physical health.
2. **CONFERENCE FEE:** The conference fee for this four-day activity is **THREE THOUSAND PESOS (P 3,000.00)** for each student and teacher delegate. This amount/fee is inclusive of board and lodging, conference materials, souvenir program EXCEPT round-trip transportation to the Conference Venue.
3. **DEADLINE:** Those interested must make their reservations either by phone, facsimile or by coming personally at the CMLI Secretariat located at Unit 7, Fersal Condominium II, 130 Kalayaan Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City with telephone nos. (FAXPhone) 924-2304 and 924-2297 on or before August 22, 1997.
4. **PRE-REGISTRATION:** A reservation is honored only upon sending of the reply form with the final list and number of participating delegates. Participants who wish to join the convention must go through this pre-registration activity on or before the deadline. Failure to comply with this would mean a non-reservation of your slot in the convention because registration during the convention would only be open to those who are pre-registered.
5. **ATTIRE:** Delegates are required to wear formal attire during the opening and closing ceremonies. Since sports activities will be held, appropriate attire is desired. Please bring enough warm clothing considering the cool weather of Baguio City.
6. **ACCOMMODATIONS FOR THE CONVENTION:** The Teachers' Camp shall provide complete bedding including one blanket and one pillow per person. Delegates are advised to bring additional blankets and pillow if they wish.

LIST OF ACTIVITIES

1. **COMMISSION DISCUSSIONS:** Delegates are grouped into different commission to engage in group dynamic sessions. Various topics related to the theme will be discussed. Leadership-training, values formation and personal interaction modules will be prepared for the benefit of the delegates.
2. **CONTESTS:** There shall be an **ART SOCIALS** Contest by block and the best performing group will be given due recognition. A **SPORTSFEST** in the form of "Laro ng Lahi" will also be held. Details will be discussed by the blocks during the conference proper.
3. **TALENT VARIETY SHOW:** A talent variety show among participating schools shall be held. Interested school delegations must prepare before hand since no time will be given for rehearsals. CMLI reserves the right to screen performers. Individual performances are given a maximum of five (5) minutes while group will be given a maximum of ten (10) minutes.
4. **COMPETITIONS FOR EXCELLENCE:** The convention shall have the following contests: story-writing contest, malikhaing pagsulat ng kuwento, story-telling contest, malikhaing pagkukuwento, poem writing and delivery contest, timpalak dagliang pagsusulat at pagtutula, and on-the-spot poster making contest. Only one student per delegation is allowed to participate in each contest. Participants are allowed to join only one contest. Contestants for the poster making should bring their own art materials.
5. **MOTIF NIGHT:** The motif night requires a slumber attire. The delegates are advised to wear comfortable but decent sleeping clothes. The Disco Socials will follow right after the motif night.
