1997 NATIONAL CHILDREN'S SCIENCE INTERACTIVE WORKSHOP



- 1. The Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs, Inc. (PSYSC) in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports and the Department of Science and Technology (DOST), announces its annual activity, the 1997 National Children's Science Interactive Workshop (CSIW) to be held on October 24-27 at the Brokenshire Training and Resource Center, Madapo Hills, Davao City for the affiliated elementary pupils nationwide.
- 2. The activity's theme shall be "Ako Ma'y Munting Tinig Sa Baya'y May Pangarap Din: Sa Tulong ng Agham, Ito'y Aking Aabutin". It aims to promote understanding of and develop interest in science, technology and the environment among elementary pupils and to inculcate among them the importance of S, T & E in nationbuilding and their role in it.
- 3. CSIW will include workshops in science, mathematics and the environment, hands-on experimentation, public exhibit of the results of these experiments, field trips, lectures, socials and other fun-filled interactive activities.
- 4. Each affiliated school is allotted three pupils (Grades IV-VI only) and one adviser. In case the school intends to send more than four (4) participants, the CSIW Secretariat should be informed in advance.
- 5. The trall expenses and registration fee of one thousand eight hered pesos (P1,800.00) incident to this activity are chargeable against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The registration fee will cover board and lodging from the evening of October 24 to lunch of October 27, hand-outs, field trips, materials and other miscellaneous expenses.

6. Interested participants must submit the following: a) duly accomplished application form which will be sent directly to the affiliated schools; b) parental consent; c) medical certificate; and d) a non-refundable reservation deposit of three hundred pesos (P300.00) per participant (deductible from the registration fee) payable only to PSYSC (preferably in Postal Money Order) not later than September 29 to:
