ORIENTATION FOR REGIONAL SUPERVISORS OF SCIENCE

To: Regional Directors
Chiefs of Secondary Education Divisions

1. The Bureau of Secondary Education will conduct an orientation program for the regional supervisors of science on September 18-19 at the BSE Conference Room, Bonifacio Building, DECS, U.L. Complex, Pasig City.

2. The orientation aims to:

- a. update the regional supervisor of the programs and projects on science education;
- b. raise the level of awareness and involvement of the science regional supervisor in the implementation of the various programs and projects in science education;
- c. review the list of standard equipment for science and technology subjects; and
- d. assist the regional supervisor in preparing a monitoring plan for these projects.

3. The participants to this orientation are the regional supervisors (GES II) for science or a representative from each of the Secondary Education Divisions of the DECS Regional Offices. The participants will be oriented on the science-oriented high schools (RSHS, LRC, ESEP High School Network, S & T High Schools) and projects on science education (PROBE, JICA Package Cooperation, NSTIC, Environmental Education, Science Across Asia Pacific Project, CONSTEL, Nuclear Science Education Training, Rural Schools Project, among others).

4. Materials, lunches and snacks for two (2) days will be provided by BSE. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
