PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION OF CHEMISTRY TEACHERS (PACT)
1997 NATIONAL CONVENTION

1. The Philippine Association of Chemistry Teachers (PACT), in cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold its Annual National Convention on October 23-24 at the University of the East, C.M. Recto, Manila.
2. The theme of this year's convention is "Chemistry Education and Infotech". The convention aims to equip the chemistry teachers with the necessary knowledge and skills to prepare the students for the rapid and complex changes that are expected in the coming century in view of the developments in Information Technology.
3. Participants in this activity are chemistry teachers in the high schools both public and private. Attendance is on official time provided substitutes shall be assigned to take over the loads of teachers involved in the said activity. Teachers who are interested to present papers or conduct workshop must submit a one-page abstract for a one hour presentation. This must include list of materials and equipment. Deadline for submission shall be on September 15.
4. Convention fees are six hundred pesos (₱600.00) and seven hundred fifty pesos (₱750.00) for pre-registered members and non-members respectively. However, on-site registration shall be seven hundred fifty pesos (₱750.00) for members and nine hundred pesos (₱900.00) for non-members. Deadline for pre-registration is October 6. Registration on the day of the convention shall start at 7:00 a.m.

5. Travel and other incidental expenses of public school teachers shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private institutions shall make arrangements with their respective institutions or sponsoring agencies.
