


1. Anchored on the ecotourism and environmental rehabilitation programs of the government and in support to its nationwide campaign on the protection of natural environment, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) through the Natural Resources Development Corporation (NRDC) and the Teamwork Production, Inc., has launched the movie "Puerto Princesa." The premier showing was held at the Meralco Theater, Pasig City on June 13.

The "Puerto Princesa" is a film which deals on the struggle of a local government official and his constituents in their pursuit of protecting the natural resources from the ravages of man, machine and nature so as to maintain an environment-friendly community. Showing the adverse effects in the biosystem caused by wastage, excessive consumption and environmental mismanagement, the film aims to create a level of awareness on wildlife conservation and preservation of the ecological richness not only in the city of Puerto Princesa but also throughout the country. It may also serve as a learning activity for the students in safeguarding the global environment and the biosystem considering the significance of the film in the government's effort to protect the natural resources.

3. Environmentalists, ecotopians, educators and high school students from public and private schools are encouraged to see the movie.
