# 2<sup>ND</sup> NATIONAL TRAUMA CONGRESS: SETTING THE MULTI-SECTORAL AGENDA FOR INJURY PREVENTION AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

- 1. The 2<sup>nd</sup> National Trauma Congress: Setting the Multisectoral Agenda for Injury Prevention and Emergency Preparedness will be held on September 26, 1997 at the Westin Philippine Plaza Hotel, CCP Complex, Pasig City. This Congress is a collaborative activity of the Alliance for Emergency Response and Training (ALERT), Philippine College of Surgeons, Philippine Medical Association, Philippine Heart Association, East Ave. Medical Center Emergency and Trauma Department, and Boston University School of Medicine.
- 2. Its objectives are to create greater awareness on current issues and emerging concerns on injury prevention and control; and to advocate for policy reforms and program development in public safety and emergency preparedness.
- 3. In view of the benefits that will be derived from the discussions of relevant topics to address the prevention of accidents and violence; and coping with emergencies, school administrators, school health personnel and school officials involved in disaster preparedness are enjoined to attend the Congress on Official Business.
- 4. The registration fee of Four Hundred Pesos Only (P400.00) shall be charged to cover the cost of lunch and snacks, conference kit and certificate of attendance. Attached is the tentative schedule of activities for ready reference.
