
CONVENTION OF THE FEDERATION OF PHILIPPINE  
MONTESSORI SCHOOLS, INC. (FPMSI)

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Private Preschool and Elementary School Principals

1. The Federation of Philippine Montessori Schools, Inc. (FPMSI) will hold a convention on "The Maria Montessori Revolution In Education" at the Maria Montessori Hall, OB Montessori Center, Inc., 3 Eisenhower St., Greenhills, San Juan, Metro Manila on September 25-26 at 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.
2. This is a two-day convention on Montessori Principles, Practices and School Management culminating with a premier theater presentation of "A Woman Called Freedom" based on the life of Dr. Maria Montessori, the woman acclaimed as one of the "Great People of the 20th Century." Cocktails will follow at the OB Montessori College Restaurant, the Ristorante La Dolce Fontana.
3. A registration fee of two thousand eight hundred pesos (P2,800.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for food (lunches and snacks for 2 days), cocktails at Restorante La Dolce Fontana, convention kit, ticket for the Montessori musical play "A Woman Called Freedom", certificate of participation and other handouts. Transportation and other allowable expenses of participants from public schools may be charged against local school funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants coming from private schools shall make financial arrangements with their respective schools.
4. In view of the significance of this convention and to understand the thrust of the Montessori System, all regions/divisions are requested to disseminate the information to all public and private pre-schools and grade schools.
