
**TRAINORS' TRAINING ON MANAGING THE SCHOOLS OF  
THE FUTURE (SOF)**

TO: Undersecretaries  
Assistant Secretaries

1. The Center for Education Technology (CET) in collaboration with the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) will conduct a two-week Trainors' Training on Managing the Schools of the Future on October 13 - 25, 1997 at the National Reservation Center, Mt. Makiling Los Baños, Laguna.
2. The training aims to a) introduce the Schools of the Future (SOF) concept; b) orient the participants on the principles and relevant issues in managing SOF; c) provide hands-on experience on the use of multimedia in classroom instruction; and d) train the participants to become core trainors of multimedia technology and instructional leaders of the SOF in their respective regions.

3. Participants to the training are three (3) representatives of the Regional Multi-media Task Force (preferably those who attended the National Orientation Training on Continuing Education held at NEAP, Teacher's Camp, Baguio City last July 18 - 25, 1996) who will implement the programs and project of SOF in their regions.
4. Travel expenses, per diems and the registration fee of Eight Thousand Pesos ( P8,000.00) for each participant shall be charged against local funds. The said fee will be used to help defray the cost of board and lodging, training materials and honoraria of resource persons. Travel expenses, per diems, board and lodging, Extra Duty Allowance (EDA) and other related expenses of training/technical staff and facilitators (see attachment) shall be charged against OSIEC funds.
5. The registration fee shall be payable to DECS (CET).
6. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is desired.

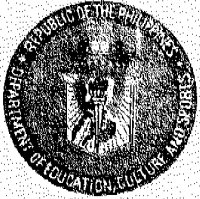

NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON ENVIRONMENT AND LIVELIHOOD



1. The Pambansang Samahan sa Sikolohiyang Pilipino (National Association for Filipino Psychology) and the Palawan State University, in coordination with this Department, will hold the National Conference on Environment and Livelihood at Puerto Princesa City on November 14-16.
2. The conference with the theme "Kapaligiran, Kabuhayan at Pagkataong Pilipino" aims to provide discourse on the role of Philippine psychology and culture in promoting public awareness on issues concerning environment, livelihood and Filipino personality, describe and discuss the policies, researches and management of our environment, focus concerted efforts for public consciousness on the significance of economic development to the people, participate in the collective action from the community to the national level for the protection and preservation of the environment.
3. Expected participants to this three-day conference are academicians, practitioners and community leaders who are involved in the efforts of preserving and protecting the environment.
4. A conference fee of one thousand pesos (P1,000.00) will be charged each participant to include conference kit and lunches and snacks for three days. Transportation, board and lodging and expenses for eco-tour of participants from government institutions may be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private schools shall make financial arrangements with their respective institutions.
