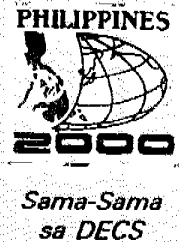

TO THE PHILIPPINE CENTENNIAL SCOUT JAMBOREE  
( 11th BSP National Jamboree )**



1. Further to DECS Memorandum No. 196, s. 1997 regarding the Philippine Centennial Scout Jamboree to be held on 05 - 11 January 1998 at Clark Field, Pampanga, this is to remind all concerned to encourage maximum attendance of Scouts and Scouters from both public and private schools nationwide.
2. The Chief Scout, President Fidel V. Ramos, has invited all country-members of the World Organization of the Scout Movement, aside from the Scout Associations from the Asia-Pacific Region and countries involved in our struggle for freedom, to participate in this grand scouting event, thereby increasing the number of projected participants to 25,000 delegates.
3. To date, we have already received confirmation of participation from both local and international delegates. We request, therefore, all concerned to organize their district, division and regional delegations to the Centennial Scout Jamboree and to confirm their attendance as soon as possible for proper coordination.
4. Since this event will be the first major activity during the centennial year, we expect no less than an outstanding and spirited participation from the field to generate profound interest, both local and international, for the centennial activities to follow until June 12, 1998.

5. In this connection, the DECS Youth Task Force of the Office of the Secretary, thru its Chairman, Mr. Joey G. Pelaez, is designated as coordinator of the Jamboree for the Department. **NATIONAL MEMORANDUM**

**To** : Regional Scout Directors, Council Scout Executives and Officers-in-Charge

**Subject** : ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON THE PHILIPPINE CENTENNIAL SCOUT JAMBOREE & 11<sup>TH</sup> NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE

1. We are pleased to announce the reduction of the Jamboree Fee from P1,200.00 to P500.00 per participant (Scout and Adult Leader) which will defray the costs for the Jamboree souvenir items, logistics, administration and program materials.
2. Council Scout Executives are advised to remit to the Jamboree Finance Officer, National Office, Manila the non-refundable but transferable registration fee of P300.00 per participant NOT LATER THAN 31 OCTOBER 1997. The remaining balance of P200.00 per participants shall be remitted NOT LATER THAN DECEMBER 5, 1997 at the National Office, Manila.
3. A Jamboree Commissary or Market shall be established within the area to cater to all the marketing needs of the campers such as poultry products, fish, fresh meat and vegetables, etc. However, the contingents are required to bring their own food supplies provided that Jamboree rules and regulations, such as total ban on live animals like pigs, goats, cattle, chickens and the like, which are intended for food in camp will be strictly observed.
4. With the reduction of the Jamboree Fee to an affordable amount for all campers, it is expected, therefore, that all local councils will exert maximum efforts to ensure the active participation of the greatest majority, especially by Scouts who are financially not capable and/or physically handicapped but meritoriously deserving.
5. Local Council Jamboree Organizing Committees are expected to provide the strongest support and assistance to their own contingents in order to ensure their meaningful and successful camping experience at the Philippine Centennial Scout Jamboree and 11<sup>th</sup> National Scout Jamboree.
6. Furthermore, entries to the Jamboree Song Contest are expected to reach the National Office not later than November 15, 1997 per N.O. Memo #38, s. 1997.
