## PAPSCU LIVELIHOOD AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP CONFERENCE

- 1. The Philippine Association of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities (PAPSCU), in coordination with this Department, amounces the holding of the PAPSCU National Conference at the Alumni Hostel, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City on October 13, 1997.
- 2. The theme of the conference is "Livelihood and Entrepreneurship Programs for the 21st Century."
